ELIGIBILITY:

This show is open to everyone aged 18
years or older.

ENTRY FEES:

Members of the Museum & Arts Center
and Sequim Arts:

\$10 for up to and including 3 pieces.

Non-members:

\$15 for up to and including 3 pieces.

Entry fees are non-refundable.

CONDITIONS:

Qualifying art must be no larger in dimension than 8" x
10" including the frame. All artwork must be for sale.
A 30% commission will be taken on all work sold.
Artists may also opt to donate all of the proceeds from
the sale of one or more of their pieces. Items not sold
will be returned to the artist.

All media will be accepted, including, but not limited to,
watercolor, oil, acrylic, pencil, pen & ink, pastel,
collage, mixed media, sculpture, ceramics, fine arts
textiles, assemblage, print making, pottery,
photography, etc.

All artwork must be original in interpretation and
composition, not copied from copyrighted or published
art.

Work must be dry, properly framed and wired for
hanging with screw eyes and wire (no saw tooth
hangers).

All work will be judged for content upon entry.
The Museum & Arts Center and the Sequim Arts show
committee reserves the right to reject any work it does
not feel depicts the theme of the show or is otherwise
inappropriate.

Upon the completion of the installation, the Museum &
Arts Center Executive Director reserves the right of
final review prior to opening and may remove pieces
that do not fit the Museum & Arts Center Exhibit
Policy, or that are not up to the hanging standards
provided in this document.

The Museum & Arts Center and Sequim Arts may use
images of your art on their websites, and in
promotional material for this exhibit. Please make the
Museum & Arts Center aware of any restrictions
beforehand.

All artwork for this show will be photographed and the
photograph displayed on the wall, until the close of the
show if the piece is sold. The Museum & Arts Center
and Sequim Arts will allow photographs to be taken by
reporters for the local press or our staff to be used for
publicity purposes only. All publication of photographs
will contain a credit line acknowledging the artist.
